Upcoming Improvements to CITGO Synthetic Gear Lubricants

CITGO Synthetic Gear Lubes SAE grades 75W-90, 80W-140 and 50 are being reformulated with new performance advantages and a new appearance. These full synthetic, heavy duty gear lubes still carry approvals for full warranty under Eaton / Roadranger / Dana, Arvinmeritor (Rockwell) and other OEM driveline specifications. This change will begin in mid-October and will continue through the fourth quarter as inventories transition at specific source points. Customers can expect a smooth transition since the newly improved version of the CITGO Synthetic Gear Lubes is completely compatible with the older version.

Making a Good Thing Better!

The advantages of this newer synthetic technology include:

- Further reduction in friction losses from heavily loaded bearings and meshing gears
- Lower operating oil temperature in extended long haul or off-road service
- Longer useful oil life in the most demanding service

The change will be apparent in a lighter color, as shown below, for the two EP wide multigrades, SAE 75W-90 and 80W-140. The SAE 50 transmission lube will still be dark but less red in color.



Other than color, there is a change in density – as these robust formulations are rich in lighter density synthetics. Products will be available in the following container sizes:
